STARLIGHT ROLLS OUT RED CARPET FOR NIGHT AT THE MOVIES

Free concert Tuesday, July 19 at Guthrie Green

Tulsa, OK—"Lights! Camera! Action!" is just one of the songs to be featured at Starlight Band's annual "Night at the Movies" concert, which is sponsored in part by Circle Cinema and Cedar Creek. The free performance will be Tuesday, July 19 at 8pm at Guthrie Green, 111 E. Brady. Other popular movie themes in the program are "Jungle Book," "Pan," "Rocky," "Star Wars," and some of the James Bond films.

After dark, the silent film "Sherlock Jr." will be screened, accompanied by live theater organ music. This 1924 comedy stars Buster Keaton as a film projectionist with aspirations of becoming a detective. He puts his questionable skills to work when he is framed by a rival for stealing a pocket watch which belongs to his girlfriend's father.

Other 2016 concert dates are Tuesday, July 26 "Band Request Night"; and Friday, August 5 "Tribute to the Vanguard Jazz Orchestra" during the Brady Arts District's "First Friday Art Crawl." Guthrie Green offers free parking and is accessible to those with disabilities. Concessions will be available.
